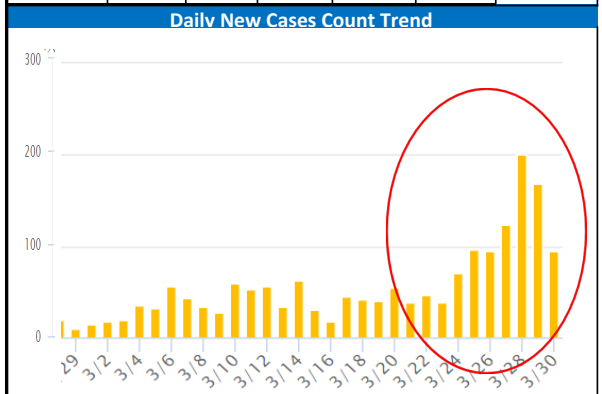

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- 1) There is considerable surge in number of cases especially in Tokyo and Osaka in last one week. Unlike India and other Asian countries, Japanese Government is deliberating it in a slow and steady way without causing much economic impact and without creating much overloads on medical infra-structure
- 2) Even though the number of cases is going up, Government is confident in saying that most of the clusters (13 as of March 17th) and sources are identified. Despite the emergence of few unidentified sources of infection which is quite worrisome, Japan thinks that it is still not in a state to declare emergency. They are closely watching the progress.
- 3) It is evident that people especially in Tokyo have increased their cautious level especially after recent recommendations from mayor to avoid all unnecessary outings and promoting work from home for companies in Japan.
- 4) Japanese government reiterates not to hoard food items and guarantees enough stockpiles of food especially rice for six months even if there is an emergency.
- 5) Japan, like other countries is focusing on curbing imported cases and local transmissions by banning entry from major Corona affected nations. Also, they are trying to implement the measures in point 3 and urge people to avoid the 3C's, Closed space, Crowded space and Close contact.
- 6) Masks and Sanitizers are still in shortage and recently Government imported 15 million masks from China which gives a little relief to the health sector having the priority.
- 7) There is good indication that the data that is coming out now is not completely of the current situation and may be past data which was held up. Sudden increase of test positive cases from 2% to 10% average after Olympic was postponed is an indication
